### EPD AVAILABLE



An Environmental Product Declaration transparently details its environmental impact across its life cycle, from raw material extraction to manufacturing, use, and end-of-life.

### ZERO VOC



Zero VOC indicates that no volatile organic compounds are present, contributing to healthier indoor environments.

### LEED CREDITS



Products with this designation may help building projects earn LEED® certification points for environmental responsibility.

### RECYCLED CONTENT: 40-60%



Tiles labeled with recycled content contain a verified percentage of materials reclaimed and reused from pre- or post-consumer sources.

### ISO 17889-1
